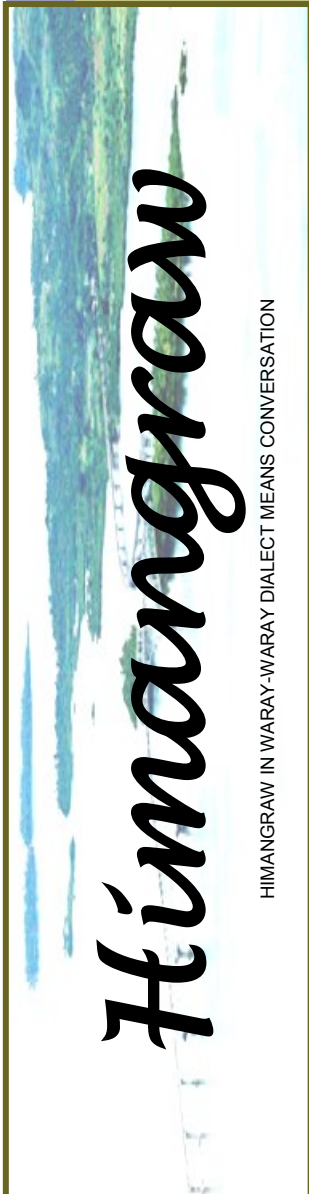

## SSCT grads land in MedTech top ten roster

John Michael D. Merin and Clive Ivan S. Mercado, both alumni of St. Scholastica's College Tacloban (SSCT), landed 5th and 9th, respectively, among the successful examinees who garnered the ten highest places in the March 2015 Medical Technologist Licensure Examination. Mr. Merin obtained a rating of 89% while Mr. Mercado's was 88%.

SSCT got a 100% passing percentage when all fourteen of its examinees passed the said licensure exam.

A total of 1, 419 out of 1, 942 examinees nationwide passed the Medical Technologist Licensure Examination or a 73.06 national passing percentage.
