RTR grad tops anew

The Remedios Trinidad Romualdez Medical Foundation (RTRMF) is again one of the top performing Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) as its alumna, Miss Krizelle Lou Cabrigas Sampayan, with a rating of 85.80%, ranked number one in the successful examinees who garnered the ten highest places in the February 2015 Physical Therapist Licensure Examination.

Just a few weeks after the RTRMF topped the performing schools in the November 2014 Nurse Licensure Exam, the said

institution ranked number four in the February 2015 Physical Therapist Licensure Examination top performing schools with 15 or more examinees and with at least 80% passing percentage. Twenty-four (24) out of thirty (30) examinees of the school passed the said examination, thus posting an 80% passing percentage.

412 out of 766 examinees passed the February 2015 Physical Therapist Licensure Examination or 53.78% national passing percentage.
